The Senior Pastor works with the church elders, deacons, and board of directors to guide the church spiritually and oversee its day-to-day operations. Successful applicants for this position will also possess excellent leadership, administrative, and organizational skills.

WLAHC is an evangelical Christian church in the Sawtelle neighborhood of West Los Angeles. Established in 1955, it is one of sixteen churches in the conference of churches in the OMS Church of North America, founded in 1921. Its congregation is multicultural and multi-generational, and it maintains English and Japanese Departments and ministries as a historically Japanese American church.

**Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Preach the majority of Sundays during the English worship service.
- Meet regularly with the church leadership (elders, deacons, and the board) to pray about and discuss important matters of the church, its operations, and its ministries.
- Meet with congregation members for pastoral counseling, personal visits, and prayer.
- Adhere to and work within the policies and guidelines of the OMS Holiness Conference.
- Work collaboratively with our church's Japanese Department, leadership, and congregation.
- Collaborate and connect with other pastors of the OMB (Ordained Ministerial Body) and OMS Holiness Conference.

- Pray with our church members and tend to their spiritual growth and needs.
- Experience serving in a community-based local church that's engaged with its community.
